## **ORDER**

## New Delhi, the 6<sup>th</sup> August, 2001.

**S.O.No......(E)** - Whereas, the Central Government, in pursuance of the judgement dated 19.06.2001 of the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat, at Ahmedabad had directed by order S.O.622 (E) dated 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2001, regarding the commodities specified in column 2 of the Schedule of that order, shall be packed in jute packaging material, for supply or distribution, in such minimum percentage, as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) of the said Schedule and further in pursuance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad dated 23.07.2001, the Central Government extended the validity of the aforesaid order, till 06.08.2001 vide S.O.No. 729 (E) dated 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2001.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Jute Packaging Materials (Compulsory use in Packing Commodities) Act, 1987 (10 of 1987), the Central Government hereby directs that the validity of the aforesaid order, expiring on 06.08.2001 shall be extended for a further period upto 31.08.2001 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.
